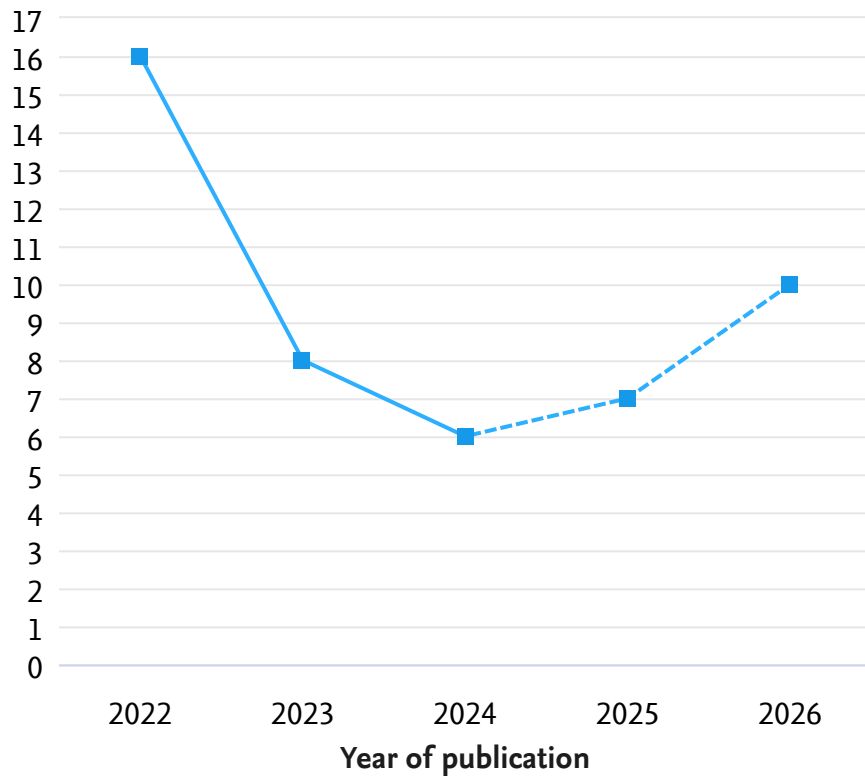

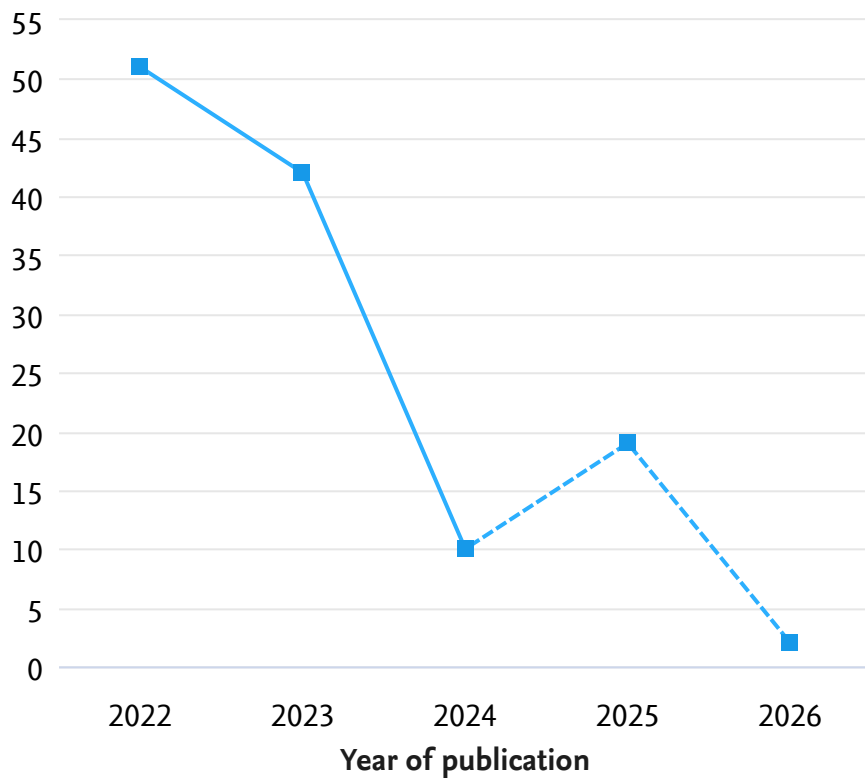

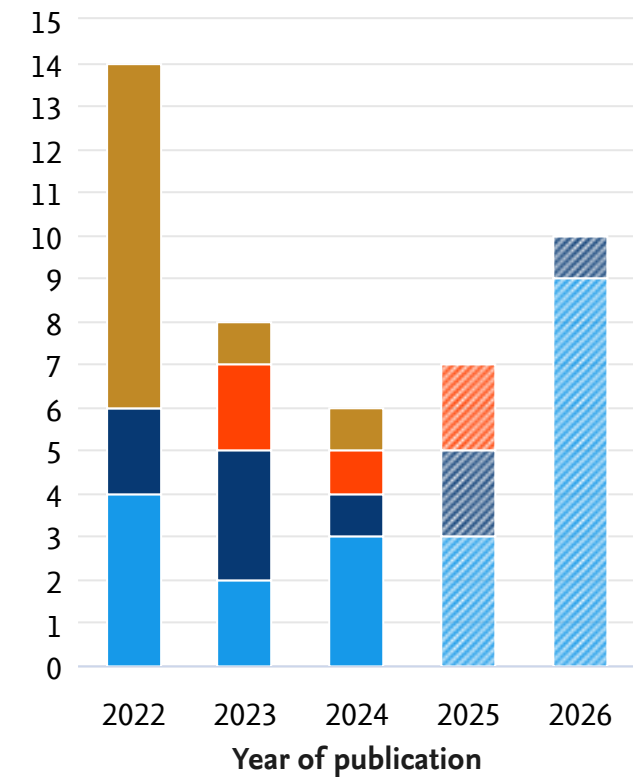

Share of publications per Journal quartile by CiteScore Percentile



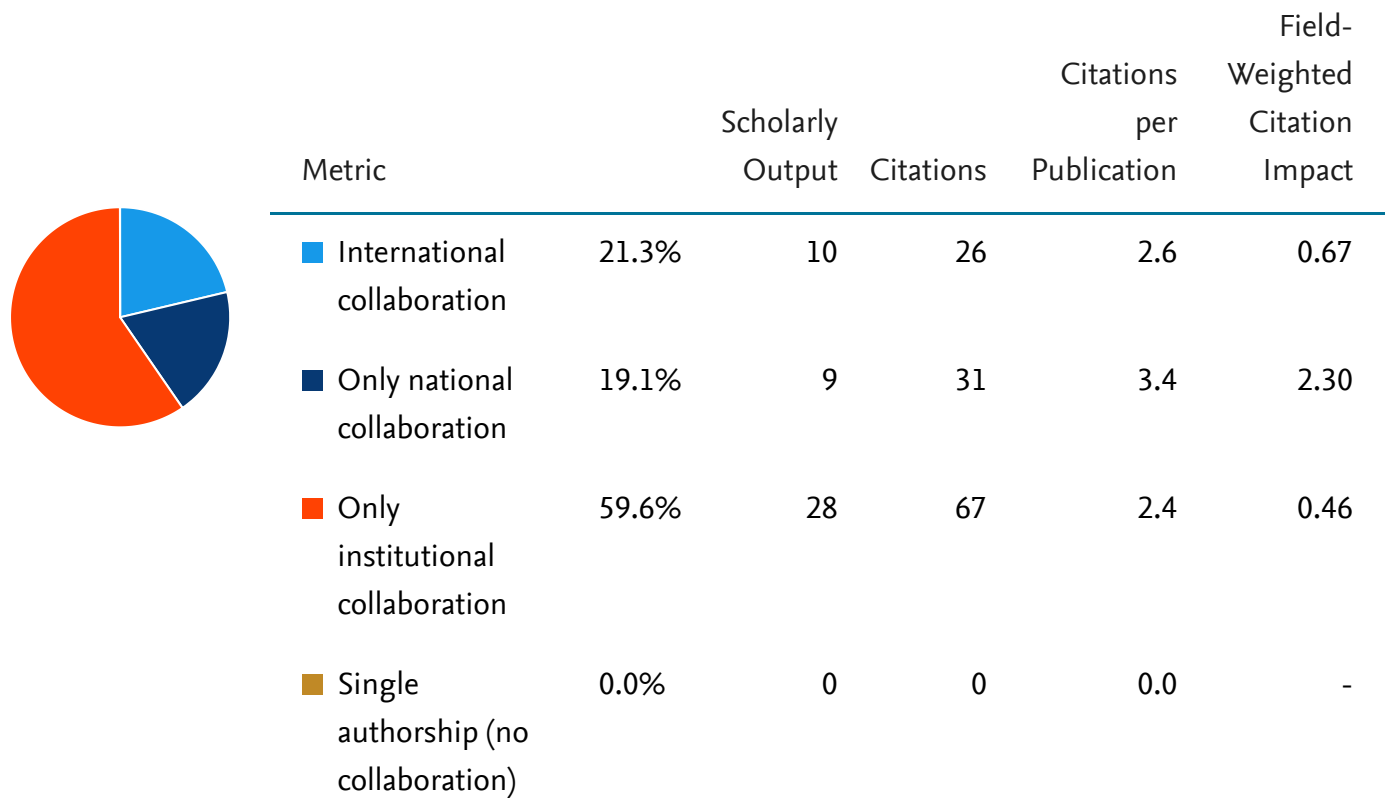

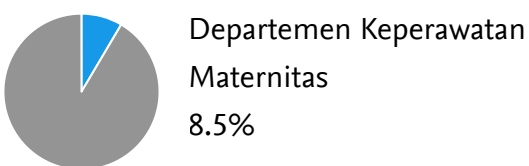

International, national and institutional collaboration by in Departemen Keperawatan Maternitas in the selected year range.



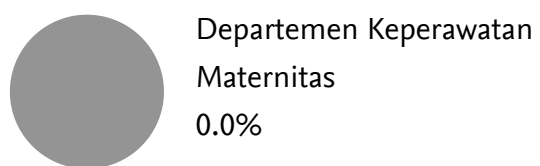
Outputs in Top 10% Citation Percentiles summary

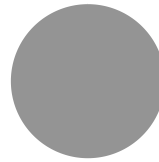
